## ABOUT MOWA Choctaw Friends Center

The MOWA Choctaw Friends Center is owned and operated by North Carolina Yearly Meeting of Friends (Quakers). The Center originally belonged to the Associated Committee of Friends on Indian Affairs (ACFIA) until the summer of 2006. The Center is located within the Sanktown community in McIntosh, Alabama and is nestled within a family-centered community.



The ministries of the Center have been greatly due to the generous donations and untiring efforts of many volunteers and caring Friends Meetings. The main ministries of the Center focus on the educational and physical needs of the community, which offer great opportunities to share the Gospel of Jesus Christ with everyone involved.

### **SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES**

**Work Groups:** A work group can choose what type of project(s) they would like to do ... anything from painting, to building a porch or wheelchair ramp, or re-roofing a home. Our Directors will assist in planning, organizing, and matching projects for your group. Work may be done in the community or on the Center property.

**Spiritual Outreach and Evangelism:** Groups may send evangelism teams to conduct 3-to-5 day worship retreats, Bible studies, or revivals. Door-to-door visitation within the community is welcomed.

**Community Connections:** Groups are invited to come and lead in the planning and implementing of a "Special Event" which may include a basketball tournament, game days, carnival, cookout, tutoring, or a backyard Bible School.

## HOUSING AND COST INFORMATION

### **Lodging and Meals**

The MOWA Choctaw Friends Center can house up to 40 persons with the following options:

**Quaker Lodge - 20 bunk beds and 3 showers**  
**Turner Hall - 20 mattresses and 4 showers**  
**Easily accommodates a group of 40 persons**

**Breakfast is continental style.**  
**Lunch and dinner are prepared by local cooks who serve a mix of traditional and local meals.**
