VBS Coordinator

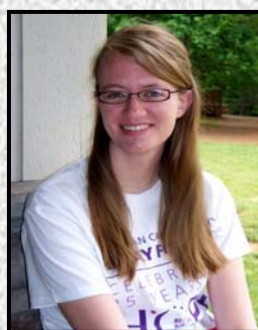
Callie grew up in Yadkinville and recently graduated from Forbush High School. She attends Union Cross Friends.

Hygiene Kits



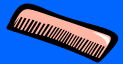
Hygiene kits are also needed at the Center. Please use gallon-size zip lock bags and include only regular size items.
