ACTIVITIES:

All ages participate in activities such as Bible study, crafts, swimming, organized recreation and group games, canoeing, ping-pong, frisbee golf, gardening, fishing, singing, campouts, and a closing campfire worship service. Campers 11 years old and older may sign up for additional activities. These may include activities such as mountain biking, scrap booking, pine cars, special crafts, dramas, guitar, woodworking, sewing, jewelry making, Alpine climbing tower, golf, fly-fishing, team sports and work projects. A wide variety of activities are offered each session allowing campers to pursue their interests and try new things.

CABIN LIFE:

Campers will stay in a cabin with a counselor along with 7 or 8 other campers. Throughout the day campers will participate in activities individually and with their cabin group. Each cabin group works as a 'family' while at camp, building community through worship, work, and play.

Located in the Piedmont Triad of North Carolina, Quaker Lake opens the door for young and old to gather with God and nature. Over 200 acres of lush woodland, open fields and a 5-acre lake provide the backdrop of Quaker Lake's inspirational setting. At Quaker Lake Camp we provide a place for children and youth to get away from the hectic world and to reconnect with nature and learn a sense of community through Christian fellowship. Each camper is provided unique opportunities to discover or strengthen their personal relationship with God.

We offer day camp for 5 and 6 year-olds, residential sessions for ages 7 to 17, family camp and off-site adventures. Our staff consists of creative, spiritual and energetic leaders who are carefully selected and trained for each individual position.

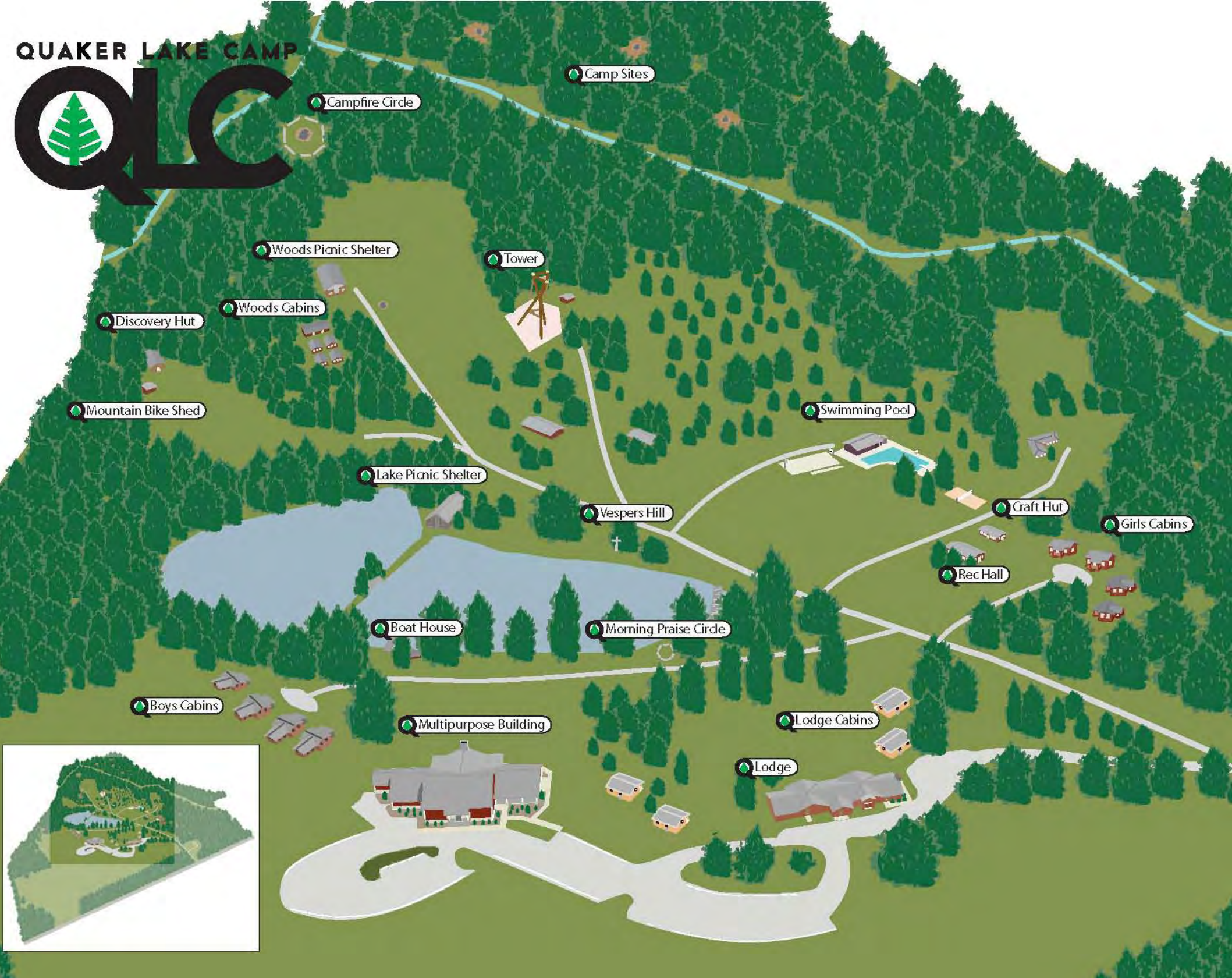
ACCREDITATIONS:
